



EXECUTIVE ORDER #89

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Fire Chief Steven Fritz of the Village of Rothschild Fire Department

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2012, Fire Chief Steven Fritz of the Rothschild Fire Department died within twenty-four hours of responding to an alarm call; and

WHEREAS, Chief Fritz was a member of the Rothschild Fire/EMS Department for nearly nineteen years, leading the Department as Fire Chief since 2007; and

WHEREAS, Chief Fritz provided faithful and honorable service to the people of Rothschild and the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Chief Fritz; and


WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Fire Chief Steven Fritz on December 15, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, December 15, 2012** and ending at sunset on that date.
